## **Wisconsin Cowboy spurs to victory**

**CLERMONT, Ind. (June 27)** – The Wisconsin Cowboy rode off into the sunset.

Rick Tackman, Jr. left no doubt in winning the 40-lap Voris Construction Late Model feature at O'Reilly Raceway Park Saturday night.

Tackman took the lead on Lap 6 and won by nearly 20 seconds on the .686-mile oval over a charging Dave Kinney, Indianapolis and Piqua, Ohio's Colin Nickolai.

"The car was perfect," a jubilant Tackman said. "I don't know what (crew chief) Russ (Willingham) changed after the dash, but it was great."

Kinney changed transmissions after practice and had to charge from the back of the field to the runner up spot.

Early leader Keith Lyons and Reed White rounded out the Top 5.

Tackman's win completed a sweep of the night. He also was fast qualifier and won the dash.

Steve Blair, Brownsburg, swept the JobCentral Pro Truck show. He led the final 37 laps for his third win of 2009. He too won the dash and was fast qualifier setting a new track record in the process.

Blair took over the point lead from second place finisher Tom Miller. Scott Brooks, last week's winner Evan Roberts and newcomer Greg VanAlst came next.

A change in the ARA schedule was announced. The Twin 100s originally scheduled for July 4 have been rescheduled for July 11. The ARA event for July 4 has been canceled. Practice and qualifying precede the 7 p.m. first green flag in two weeks.
